



## PhD National Security Workshop

This workshop aims to continue previous efforts by the RNSA to build a network of PhD researchers and match PhD researchers with national security staff who may be interested in their work.



Specifically for PhD researchers, this workshop aims to provide an opportunity to:

- develop a network with other researchers working in a similar research space;
- learn of research needs from the practitioner community;
- present and discuss your research;
- learn about how to conceptualise your research in policy terms;
- learn about how to develop strategies to engage policy-makers;
- become informed of the range of employment opportunities open to you; and
- meet delegates representing the national security community who may be interested in the outcome of your research project.

The workshop will be held during the first day of Safeguarding Australia 2009 (SA 09) Conference (**5 August 2009**) in Canberra from 10:15 am. PhD participants will be able to attend either of the two forums (Resilience/Safety & Security) at cost price (\$100) on 6 August 2009.
